



Special treatment and calendar for IGCSE students



Welcome to the IGCSE exams! The school decided to facilitate your preparation. Read carefully this special treatment you will have in May and check the special calendar made for you.

Students who take 3 or more IGCSE exams will...

29th April – 21st May (IGCSE exam period)

- ... **not attend normal classes** during the IGCSE exam period (those days when they have exams or preparatory lessons)
- ... obligatorily **attend the special preparatory lessons for their IGCSE subjects** (“prep day”)
- “Prep days” are preparatory lessons given/invigilated/guided by the teacher of the IGCSE subject of their choice until 15:00 on the day prior to the exam. They can go home after the preparatory lesson, if the parents give the corresponding authorization.

22nd May – 31st May (School term exam period)

- ... will **NOT SIT ANY “REGULAR” END OF TERM EXAMS** of the non-IGCSE students
- ... will **attend intensive courses under a special schedule**
 - to catch up with the class work they may have missed, to be assessed **on SOME Spanish** curriculum subjects under special considerations and to get a mark for the third term
 - the mark given in these courses counts for no more than 20% of their end of term mark
 - students will **be marked** in term 3 in each subject **based on their performance until 26th April**
 - students will get their end of term marks published by midnight of 31st May
 - normal school rules apply for these courses

3rd – 5th June (School global exam period)

- ... will **sit the global exams** of some subjects or/and **can also sit** the “*opciones de subida de nota*” exams

General commitment

- Students will be responsible with the special treatment received and will be responsible and committed at all times
- Students will also do everything to avoid misunderstanding (any misconduct will result in the withdrawal of the privileges)

NOTE! Students with 2 or fewer IGCSE exams will attend the preparatory classes (29th April – 20th May) for their IGCSE subjects, but they are expected to attend lessons normally and catch up with the work they may have missed due to the exam preparation / exams. They will also take the normal end of term exams with the non-IGCSE students.
