ADMISSION PROCESS SUMMARY

1. INFORMATION:

When a family is interested in our school, they can information through our main channels: [website](#), social [networks](#), and they can proceed to book a school visit with our admissions department: admisiones@highlandselencinar.es

2. INITIAL INTERVIEW

Once their enquiry has been received, the school will contact the family to arrange a first meeting at the school, visit our facilities and get to know everything about our Sixth Form.

At this stage, a meeting/interview is organised with the admissions officer and Head of Sixth Form. Other members of the teaching body or SLT may attend this initial meeting, or a second meeting can be arranged depending on the individual needs.

Before the interview, families will be asked about:

- How they learnt about us/initial interest
- Reasons for choosing the A Level programme
- Personal details: name, address, DOB, contact details etc.
- Academic background

The meeting is held with:

- Parents: to share our school ethos & mission
- Student: to know them more in depth and gather their needs

3. DIAGNOSTIC ASSESSMENTS:

Once the family agrees to continue with the enrolment process; having seen first-hand the school and the educational project, the students' support department will give the student psycho-pedagogical and academic tests to obtain more information about their learning and development.

These tests might not be deemed necessary if the student has recent reports/diagnosis and recent official certification of language proficiency in English.



4. ENROLMENT:

Once the school is ready to offer the student a placement, the family is directed to an online registration platform where they can upload all the necessary documentation for formal enrolment.

5. SUBJECT CHOICE:

The Sixth Form A level programme allows students to tailor their academic programme to their interests and future career choices. Before enrolment, specific entry requirements for each subject will be discussed with the Head of Sixth Form.
